1. Venue

Since this year's event will be held online, it will be posted in electronic form on the website prepared by DPRI.

2. Date and time

- Posters will be displayed from 18 February to 22 February 2022(JST).

Poster core time is from 12:30 to 14:30 on 21 February (JST).

3. Poster Format

Divide what you normally include in a poster into 4-8 horizontally long slides. Then save it in PDF or PowerPoint format. The reason is to make it easier to see on the PC screen.

In addition, you can post one video (MP4 format, within 500MB) to introduce the bulletin board.

4. Poster data Submission method

Please submit the PowerPoint or PDF format file by 13:00 on February 17, 2022 (JST).

For the submission method, please refer to the "Online Poster Presentation Procedure Manual" that is sent only to the presenters at the end of January.

5. Presentation method at core time

Presenters must wait in the breakout room with their presentation number in the Zoom venue from the beginning to the end of the applicable core time.

*If you plan to be absent or will be partially absent during core time, please submit the "leaving time schedule" together with your presentation data.

In case of an emergency or sudden decline of presentation, please contact the Zoom venue manager of each session. If you cannot contact the person in charge of the venue, please contact the general reception/ support office - 0774-38-3350.

When participants come into the breakout room, please share the poster data on the Zoom screen and give a short presentation of about 3 to 5 minutes and a question and answer session.
